



The Directorate-General for Trade is organising a stakeholder briefing session during the second round of the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) negotiations which will take place in Brussels from 7 to 11 October 2013. During this session, stakeholders will be briefed by the EU and US chief negotiators on the status of the negotiations and will have the opportunity to exchange views with chief negotiators of both sides.
