

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Request for an amendment of the Anti-Dumping Regulation 412/2013 -

A. The products concerned

The products concerned by the Anti-Dumping Regulation 412/2013 are ceramic tableware and kitchenware, excluding ceramic knives, ceramic condiment or spice mills and their ceramic grinding parts, ceramic peelers, ceramic knife sharpeners and cordierite ceramic pizza stones of a kind used for baking pizza or bread falling at the time within CN codes ex 60 11 10 00, ex 6912 00 10, 6912 00 30, ex 6912 00 50 and ex 6912 00 90 and originating in the PRC.

B. Case Summary

1. The original investigation showed that the products excluded from the scope are fundamentally different from traditional ceramic kitchen- and tableware in terms of physical characteristics, production processes and end-uses.
2. This distinction should be applied to other ceramic kitchenware and tableware that are made of the same raw material of zirconia, in a dry-burning production process and with use as kitchen tools to prepare food.

C. Request

Therefore, the applicant requests to amend the Anti-Dumping regulation 412/2013 and exclude from the scope furthermore ceramic slicers, ceramic graters, ceramic scissors, ceramic scrapers, ceramic sharpeners and ceramic coffee mills.
