



UKRAINE - DEFINITIVE SAFEGUARD MEASURES ON CERTAIN PASSENGER CARS

COMMUNICATION FROM UKRAINE

The following communication, dated 6 October 2015, was received from the delegation of Ukraine with the request that it be circulated to the Dispute Settlement Body (DSB).

On 20 July 2015 the Dispute Settlement Body ("DSB") adopted its recommendations and rulings in the dispute *Ukraine – Definitive Safeguard Measures on Certain Passenger Cars* (WT/DS468/R and WT/DS468/R/Add.1).

In a communication dated 17 August 2015 Ukraine informed the DSB of its intention to implement the recommendations and rulings of the DSB in this dispute (WT/DS468/9).

With respect to the DSB's recommendations and rulings, the Interdepartmental Commission on International Trade took the decision of 10 September 2015 No. SP-335/2015/4442-06 revoking the safeguard measures on imports of passenger cars. This decision entered into force from 30 September 2015.

NOTICE

On revocation of the safeguard measures on imports of cars in Ukraine regardless of their country of origin and export

On 10 September 2015 the Interdepartmental Commission on International Trade (hereinafter – Commission) has considered information provided by the Ministry of Economic Development and Trade of Ukraine on the necessity to revoke the safeguard measures on imports of cars in Ukraine regardless of their country of origin and export, applied by the Decision of the Commission of 28 April 2012 No. SP-275/2012/4423-08.

After reviewing these materials and taking into account the legal obligations in the Understanding on rules and procedures governing the settlement of disputes the Commission has established that the national interests of Ukraine require a revocation of the safeguard measures on imports of cars in Ukraine regardless of their country of origin and export in order to implement the recommendations in the dispute *Ukraine – Motor Cars* (DS468).

Taking into account the abovementioned and pursuant to the provisions of the Articles 7, 17, and 19 of the Law of Ukraine "On the application of safeguard measures on imports to Ukraine" the Commission adopted the decision No. SP-335/2015/4442-06 of 10 September 2015 on revocation of the measures adopted by the Commission's Decision of 28.04.2012 No. SP-275/2012/4423-08.

The Commission's Decision of 10 September 2015 No SP-335/2015/4442-06 shall take effect from 30 September 2015.
