Dear Ambassador,

With reference to the notification contained in document G/SECRET/32, I would like to inform you that, pursuant to the procedures and guidelines for negotiations under GATT Article XXVIII, Brazil holds principal supplying interest in relation to concessions on items 1602.3211 and 1602.3230 and substantial interest as to concessions on item 1602.3290. With respect to the latter, Brazil's claim is based upon the fact that Brazil accounted for at least 10% of EU's average imports in 2006-2008. In light of that, Brazil reserves its rights to enter into negotiations and/or consultations with the European Communities for the modification of the above-mentioned concessions.
