In the communication G/SECRET/32 submitted to the World Trade Organization, the European Union notified that it intended to modify the concessions on items 16022010, 16023211, 16023230, 16023290, 16023921, 16023929, 16023940 and 16023980 included in its tariff schedule in accordance with the provisions of Article XXVIII of GATT 1994.

China, as a Member with principal supplying interest, requests that the European Union enter into negotiations with China under Article XXVIII for the modifications of concessions with respect to relevant tariff lines. The statistics of imports of the European Union from China in the previous three years are hereby enclosed.
