to address the absorption of the anti-dumping measures imposed
on imports of continuous filament glass fibre fabrics from Egypt**

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1. The product concerned and the like product

1. The product concerned by this Request is the same as in AD653, namely fabrics of woven, stitched or woven and stitched continuous filament glass fibre rovings or yarns, excluding (i) products which are impregnated or pre-impregnated (pre-preg), and (ii) open mesh fabric with cells with a size of more than 1.8 mm in both length and width and weighing more than 35 g/m², consigned from Egypt, whether declared as originating in Egypt or not, currently falling under combined nomenclature (CN) codes ex 7019 3900, ex 7019 4000, ex 7019 5900 and ex 7019 9000.

2. Summary of the Request

2. On 6 April 2020, following investigation AD653, Regulation 2020/492¹ imposed definitive AD measures of 20% on EU GFF imports from Egypt ("initial measures"). Subsequent to the imposition of the initial measures, landed EU import prices of GFF from Egypt decreased sharply. In the absence of other factors to explain such a price drop, this sharp decrease provides strong *prima facie* evidence that the two related Egyptian exporting producers have been absorbing the AD duties on GFF imports from Egypt.
3. TECH-FAB Europe e.V., an association of EU producers of glass fibre fabrics ("GFF"), requests that the European Commission re-open the AD investigation AD653 in accordance with Article 12 of the Basic Anti-Dumping ("AD") Regulation² with a view to increasing the AD duty imposed on GFF imports from Egypt to a level that addresses the absorption of the existing measures by the Egyptian exporting producers.
